**PUBLIC HEALTH ACT, R.S.A. C. P125****PUBLIC HEALTH (LANDING OF PASSENGERS) (SPECIAL EXEMPTIONS)  
REGULATIONS, 2021**

---

Regulations made by the Minister with approval of Executive Council under section 8(c)(x) of the Public Health Act, R.S.A. c. P125.

AND WHEREAS section 8 of the said Act provides that the Minister may, with the approval of the Executive Council, make regulations for the proper execution and carrying out of the purposes and provisions of the Act generally and in particular with respect to certain specified matters;

AND WHEREAS under section 8(c)(x) the Minister may make regulations regulating the entry or departure by aircraft, ships, vessels or boats to or from any place in Anguilla, and the landing and disinfection of passengers or cargoes thereon;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue and in the exercise of the powers vested in me by sections 2 and 8 of the Public Health Act, I, Dr. Ellis Lorenzo Webster, Minister of Health, by and with the approval of the Executive Council, hereby make the Regulations, which shall now follow:

**Interpretation**

1. For the purpose of these Regulations—

“PCR COVID-19 test” has the meaning given in the Rules;

“Rules” means the Quarantine (COVID-19) (Arriving Passengers Health Clearance) Rules, 2020.

**Permission to land granted by the Minister**

2. Notwithstanding sections 4(5), 5(1) and (2) and 6(1) of the Rules, the Minister may, in exceptional circumstances, permit passengers who have not obtained an electronic certificate in accordance with section 4(5), to land in Anguilla, subject to the conditions specified in section 3.

**Conditions to be complied with by passengers**

3. The passengers referred to in section 2 shall comply with the following conditions—

- (a) on arrival in Anguilla, all passengers shall submit to a PCR COVID-19 test in accordance with section 9 of the Rules;
- (b) passengers shall remain in isolation until the results of the PCR COVID-19 test have been received;
- (c) passengers shall comply with the quarantine or isolation requirements set out in section 10 of the Rules;



- (d) passengers shall comply with any instruction given by an officer pursuant to section 11 of the Rules;
- (e) passengers shall comply with the mandatory wearing of monitoring devices in accordance with section 10A of the Rules; and
- (f) passengers shall comply with the protocols specified in the Schedule to the Rules.

**Offence**

4. A passenger referred to in section 2 who breaches the Rules commits an offence under section 7(2) of the Quarantine Act.


**Commencement and expiry**

5. These Regulations shall come into force on 29 May 2021 and shall expire on 30 June 2021.

**Citation**

6. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Landing of Passengers) (Special Exemptions) Regulations, 2021.
