Further to EX MIN 20/157 of 26 March, Council agreed that the following establishments should remain operational during the period 26 March to 9 April 2020 pertaining to restricted measures on the COVID-19:

- (1) shipping agents
- (2) radio stations
- (3) private security companies and services
- (4) companies supplying oxygen and health services supplies
- (5) construction services and hardware stores
- (6) automotive supply stores and services

Council agreed the amendments to the Public Health (Temporary Restrictions on Public Gatherings) Regulations, 2020.

Council thanked Mrs Serena Banks and Ms Keri Horsford, Parliamentary Counsels in the Attorney General's Chambers for their great work on the drafting of the Regulations.
