REGULATIONS, 2021**

Regulations made by the Minister with approval of Executive Council under section 8 of the Public Health Act, R.S.A. c. P125.

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, the principal Regulations means Public Health (COVID-19 Regulation of Ports) Regulations, 2020 (R.A. 93/2020).

Amendment of section 1

2. Section 1 of the principal Regulations is amended by deleting the definition of “specified period” and substituting it with the following—

““specified period” means 7 May 2021 to 20 May 2021”.

Amendment of section 2

3. Section 2 of the principal Regulations is amended by—

(a) deleting subsection (1) and substituting it with the following—

“(1) The entry or departure by aircraft, ships, vessels, or boats to or from any place in Anguilla is prohibited during the specified period.”; and

(b) inserting the following new paragraph immediately after paragraph (c)—

“(ca) aircrafts, ships, vessels or boats used for the repatriation of—

(i) Anguilla citizens sent overseas by the Health Authority of Anguilla or a private health care provider to seek medical treatment, and

(ii) any persons who accompanied the citizens referred to in sub-paragraph (i).”.

4. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (COVID-19 Regulation of Ports) (Amendment) (No. 5) Regulations, 2021.
