CUSTOMS ACT, R.S.A. C. C169
CUSTOMS (DUTY EXEMPTION) (HURRICANE IRMA RELIEF) (NO. 2)
REGULATIONS, 2017

Regulations made by the Governor in Council under section 76(1)(b) of the Customs Act, R.S.A c169.

Exemption of Customs duty

1. Customs duty and customs surcharge are hereby exempt for the benefit of—
 - (a) churches, benevolent societies and community organizations;
 - (b) private businesses; and
 - (c) private individuals;

in respect of building materials and furnishings as specified in Schedule 1 for the purpose of facilitating the recovery and reconstruction process through the repair, reconstruction and refurnishing of their buildings.

Period of exemption

2. The period of the exemption in respect of the payment of customs duty and customs surcharge is from the 6th day of September 2017 until the 31st day of December 2017.

Conditions

3. (1) All applications for exemption under this Regulation shall be in the form specified in Schedule 2 supported by all relevant documents.

(2) The Customs Department will conduct periodic audits to ensure end use compliance in accordance with the information and purpose presented in support of the application.

Penalty

4. Any person who makes any false statement on his application for exemption or produces any supporting document which is false commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine of \$10,000 and 6 months imprisonment.

Citation and commencement

5. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs (Duty Exemption) (Hurricane Irma Relief) (No. 2) Regulations, 2017 and is deemed to have come into force on 6th day of September 2017.
