MINUTES OF EXECUTIVE COUNCIL DECISION AGREED BY ROUND ROBIN

The following was approved by Round Robin on **Friday 26th May 2023**: -

EX MIN 23/171 **EX MEMO 23/135 APPLICATION TO HOST RAFFLE AND EXEMPTION FROM PUBLIC LOTTERIES TAX – VIVIEN VANTERPOOL PRIMARY SCHOOL**

The Vivien Vanterpool Primary School are holding a raffle to raise funds and defray the costs of graduation. The applicant has reported that they intend to sell 300 physical tickets at US\$10 each and the raffle will take place on June 20.

Council:

- 1) noted that in respect of every lottery ticket sold there is a duty charged at the rate of 10% of the price of the ticket. Raffle tickets are defined as lottery tickets;

EX MEMO 23/137 WAIVER OF TEMPORARY FOOD PREMISES PERMIT FOR THE ANNUAL WELCHES VILLAGE FEST

The Welches Community will host its annual 'Village Fest' on Monday 29th May, 2023, at the Frederick Harrigan Playing Field in Welches from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The festival will provide patrons with an authentic experience of life in Anguilla as it will showcase traditional food, music, implements and more. A request has been made for a waiver of the fees for the Temporary Food Premises Permit to allow them to operate on that day.

Council:

- 1) noted that in respect of the activity proposed a permit is required. To support persons participating in the Welches Village Fest whilst controlling potential revenue loss associated with such support it is proposed to exempt the permit fees for that day in accordance with the Financial Administration and Audit Act;
- 2) noted that the grant of the requested waiver from fees may result in tax loss of up to EC\$600.00;
- 3) approved the application by the Welches Community for a waiver from Temporary Food Premises Permit fees associated with the annual Welches Village Fest; and
- 4) noted that no Regulation in accordance with section 16 of the Financial Administration and Audit Act is needed as the sum to be waived is less than EC\$1,000.00.
