**PROCLAMATION APPOINTING A DATE FOR HOLDING A
GENERAL ELECTION**

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS by section 64 of the Constitution of Anguilla it is provided that a general election shall be held at such time within two months after every dissolution of the House of Assembly as the Governor shall by Proclamation appoint;

AND WHEREAS the House of Assembly was dissolved on the 6th day of January 2010;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the power and duty conferred upon me by the said Constitution of Anguilla, I ALISTAIR HARRISON, Governor of Anguilla, **DO HEREBY ORDER AND APPOINT** that a general election shall be held on the 15th day of February 2010.

AND all Her Majesty's officers and loving subjects of Anguilla and all those to whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to govern themselves accordingly.
