


THE CONSTITUTION OF ANGUILLA

PROCLAMATION TO DISSOLVE THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY

BY HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (2) of section 63 of the Constitution of Anguilla, that the Governor, acting after consultation with the Chief Minister, may at any time, by Proclamation dissolve the House of Assembly;

AND WHEREAS the Governor has on the 5th day of January 2010 consulted with the Chief Minister;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Alistair Harrison, Governor of Anguilla, in exercise of the power vested in me by the said Constitution of Anguilla, DO BY THIS PROCLAMATION DISSOLVE THE HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY on this 6th day of January 2010.

AND all Her Majesty's officers and loving subjects of Anguilla and all those to whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to govern themselves accordingly.
