

Season's Spark for Senior Citizens EC\$500 Grant for Seniors (70+)

The EC\$500 Grant for persons aged 70 and older who are resident in Anguilla will be administered through a structured process to ensure efficient and accurate payment.

(Primary Method)

Payments via Social Security Board

Eligible residents who already receive Social Security benefits will be paid through a transfer to the Social Security Board.

Persons receiving Social Security benefits are not required to take any action

Payments can only be applied for persons currently receiving benefits to local bank accounts.

These payments are anticipated to be made on or before 15 December, 2025.

If the credit is not received by 15 December, 2025 persons may contact Social Security or the Ministry of Finance for assistance.



(Secondary Method)

Payments Registration for Eligible Residents Not Receiving Social Security Benefits; Payments Via The Treasury Department

Residents aged 70+ who do not receive Social Security benefits must register in person at the Treasury Department.

The registration period runs from 1 December to 12 December, 2025.

Required documents:

- · Valid identification (passport, driver's licence, or national ID); and
- Banking details for a local bank account into which the grant will be paid.
- Persons should present official proof of account information (bank book, voided cheque, printed statement, or confirmation letter).
- The account must be in the individual's own name, as this will be matched to bank records prior to payment.

Verification and Payment

After registration, verification of bank account details will be conducted. Payments to those registered through the Treasury Department are expected to be made on or before 24 December, 2025 once verification is complete.

Exceptionally, where no local bank account is available, a cheque may be issued in the senior's name. These payments will be processed after 24 December, 2025.
