

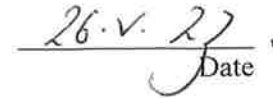

CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND (APPROPRIATION) ACT, 2023

[Gazette Dated: 26th May, 2023] [Commencement: Assent under section 57 of the Constitution]

An Act to provide for the appropriation of funds for the financial year ending the 31st day of December, 2023 to build a new classroom block and technology lab at the Vivien Vanterpool Primary School.

ENACTED by the Legislature of Anguilla

Interpretation

1. (1) In these Regulations—

“Minister” means the Minister of Finance.

(2) This Act shall be read together with the Capital Development Fund Regulations, 2022.

Appropriation of funds for expenditure

2. The Minister is authorised to appropriate the sum of one million, four hundred and eighty seven thousand, six hundred and forty dollars (\$1,487,640) towards defraying the charges and expenses from the construction and overall development of a new classroom block and technology lab at the Vivien Vanterpool Primary School.

Sums charged on Capital Development Fund

3. The sum of one million, four hundred and eighty seven thousand, six hundred and forty dollars (\$1,487,640) is charged upon and made payable out of the Capital Development Fund.

Authority to pay

4. The Accountant General or a public officer authorised by the Minister, shall pay the appropriated sums under section one out of the Capital Development Fund in accordance with the warrant of the Minister.

Citation

5. This Act may be cited as the Capital Development Fund (Appropriation) Act, 2023.

OBJECT & REASON
(Does not form part of the Bill)
