IMMIGRATION AND PASSPORT ACT, R.S.A. c. I5

IMMIGRATION AND PASSPORT (EXEMPTION) REGULATIONS, 2023

Regulations made by the Governor under section 14(2) of the Immigration and Passport Act.

WHEREAS on 7 August 2020 His Majesty's Government issued guidelines regarding the validity of Venezuelan passports confirming that Venezuelan passports that were issued or expired on or before 21 May 2019 may be considered valid by UK authorities for 5 years beyond their expiry date with no requirement for an extension stamp, sticker or official marking;

NOW THEREFORE based on these guidelines, the Governor makes the following Regulations—

Exemption from requirement to produce valid passport

1. (1) In exercise of the power granted to the Governor in accordance with section 14(2) of the Immigration and Passport Act, I, Dileeni Daniel Selvaratnam, Governor of Anguilla, exempt Jesus David Aldana Bracho from being in possession of a valid passport in accordance with the above and section 14(1) of the Immigration and Passport Act.

(2) Using Venezuelan Passport No.: 143482860, Jesus David Aldana Bracho shall be allowed to enter and leave Anguilla freely for a period of 1 year from the date of entry into Anguilla.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration and Passport (Exemption) Regulations, 2023.
