## FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION AND AUDIT ACT R.S.A. C. F27.

**REMITTANCE (LOTTERY DUTY) REGULATIONS, 2023**

Regulations made by the Governor in Council with the approval of the House of Assembly under section 16 of the Financial Administration and Audit Act, R.S.A. c. F27.

WHEREAS the Public Lotteries Tax Act requires that there shall be charged, levied and paid for every lottery ticket a duty called the "lottery duty" unless the Governor in Council provides an exemption on the basis that the net proceeds of the public lottery are not intended to be used for private gain but rather for charitable purposes; and

WHEREAS the M/V Captain Chrissy has requested an exemption from the payment of the lottery duty on the basis that the proceeds of the sale of tickets would be used to support activities during the Anguilla Summer Festival and other community events;

NOW THEREFORE the Governor in Council makes the following Regulations—

**Remittance of lottery duty**

1. The Governor in Council remits the lottery duty owed by the M/V Captain Chrissy in the sum of US\$11,000 to the Government of Anguilla.

2. These Regulations may be cited as the Remittance (Lottery Duty) Regulations, 2023.
