**DOGS (INJURY TO POULTRY AND SMALL STOCK) (AMENDMENT) ACT,  
2020**

An act to amend the Dogs (Injury to Poultry and Small Stock) Act, R.S.A. c. D40

ENACTED by the Legislature of Anguilla

**Interpretation**

1. In this Act, “principal Act” means the Dogs (Injury to Poultry and Small Stock) Act, R.S.A. c. D40.

**Amendment of section 3**

2. The principal Act is amended by deleting section 3(1) and substituting it with the following—

“3. (1) It shall be lawful for the Animal Control Officer or a police officer to destroy either by shooting with a firearm or by killing in some other manner which will cause as little pain as possible any dog whilst it is chasing small stock or poultry at any time or place.”
