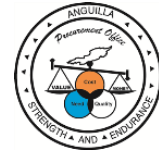

**Construction of Princess Alexandra Hospital's Perimeter Wall

The *Health Authority of Anguilla* intends to apply a budgetary allocation to payments under a contract for *Construction of Princess Alexandra Hospital's Perimeter Wall*. The *Procuring Entity* now invites sealed *bids* from eligible bidders for the *Construction of Princess Alexandra Hospital's Perimeter Wall*, as defined within the bidding documents. The contract period is for **four (4) weeks** with the option of **one (1) month** extension at the discretion of **HAA**.

Bidding will be conducted through a Competitive *Bid* procedure in keeping with the Public Procurement and Contract Administration Acts and Regulations.

A complete set of bidding documents may be purchased by interested bidders upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **EC\$100.00** payable at the Treasury Department. The bidding documents can then be collected from the Procurement Office upon presentation of the receipt obtained from the Treasury Department. A pre-bid meeting will be held at *The Princess Alexandra Hospital* on **Friday, 4th January, 2018 at 1:00 pm**.

Bids should be received no later than **Friday, 8th February, 2019 at 12:00 noon**. Late bids will be rejected. *Bids* will be opened publicly at the Ministry of Finance on **Friday, 8th February, 2019 at 2:00 pm**. The HAA is not bound to accept the lowest of any bids. This bid process may be cancelled or rejected without any liability to HAA.
