
Revised Regulations of Anguilla: C169-3

CUSTOMS ACT (R.S.A. c. C169)

CUSTOMS (OVERTIME FEES) REGULATIONS

Note: These Regulations are enabled under section 6 of the Customs Act, R.S.A. c. C169.

Interpretation

1. In these Regulations, “usual hours of business” means—
 - (a) from 8.00 a.m. to 12 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. on week days at the main office of the Customs Department;
 - (b) from 7.00 a.m. to 11.00 p.m. daily at the Customs office at the airport;
 - (c) from 7.00 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily at the Customs office at Blowing Point;
 - (d) from 8.30 a.m. to 12 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. on week days and 8.30 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays at the Customs office at Road Bay;
 - (e) from 8.00 a.m. to 12 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. daily at the Marine Base at Road Bay;
 - (f) from 9.30 a.m. to 12 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m. on weekdays and 8.30 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays at the Wallblake Warehouse; and
 - (g) from 9.00 a.m. to 12 noon and 1.00 p.m. to 4.30 p.m. daily, except on Sundays, at the Blowing point warehouse.

Overtime fees to Customs officers

2. The overtime fees payable in respect of the services of boarding, clearing and visiting a vessel or aircraft or any other service rendered by customs officers—
 - (a) outside the usual hours of business shall be \$30 per hour or part of an hour for each officer engaged; and
 - (b) on public holidays at any of the ports, except the airport and that part of the Blowing Point port and Marine Base which provides customs services to passengers, shall be \$30 per hour or part of an hour for each officer engaged.
