Interpretation**1.** In this Order—

“Act” means the Drugs Trafficking Offences Act;

“appropriate authority of a designated country” means—

- (a) the authority specified opposite that country in Schedule 1 to this Order; or
- (b) where no authority is so specified, the authority appearing to the Court to be the appropriate authority of that country for the purposes of sections 25 and 26 of the Act, and of the other provisions of the Act as applied under section 2(2) of this Order;

“Court” means the High Court;

“Court of a designated country” includes a Court of any state or territory of a designated country;
