Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by sections 5 and 7 of the West Indies Act 1962<sup>1</sup> and section 1 of the Anguilla Act 1980<sup>2</sup> and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

**Citation and Commencement**

**1.** (1) This Order may be cited as the Caribbean Territories (Abolition of Death Penalty for Murder) Order 1991.

(2) This Order shall come into force on 10<sup>th</sup> May 1991.

**Extent of Order**

**2.** (1) This Order extends to the following territories—

Anguilla

British Virgin Islands

Cayman Islands

Montserrat

Turks and Caicos Islands

(2) In the application of this Order to any of the said territories the expression “the Territory” means that territory.
