ANGUILLA'S CONSUMER PRICE INDEX March 2003

The Anguilla Consumer Price Index (AXACPI) recorded a decline of 0.2%, for the month of March. This compares with an increase of 1.4% for the month of February 2003. When compared to the same period for 2002 the CPI shows a decline of 1.4%, which means that inflation, as measured by the CPI is on a decline.

The largest increase for the month occurred in the Fuel category, which increased by 2.3% as shown in Table 1. This increase was caused by the fuel surcharge on electricity consumed.

The index also saw an increase in the Education category of 1.2% caused by price changes in school supplies.

There were minor increases in the Transport & Communication and Services categories of 0.3% each and in Clothing & Footwear of 0.2%.

The category experiencing the largest decline in prices for the month amounting to 2.5% was the Accommodation category with building materials being the major contributor. This was followed closely by the Other category with 2.3%.

There were slight declines in the Household Goods category of 0.6% and 0.1% in the Drinks and Tobacco category.

There were no changes in the Food and Medical categories.
