

Anguilla: International Merchandise Trade Statistics Summary February 2004

Imports to Anguilla for the month of February 2004 decreased by 9.8% compared to February 2003. This is a reversal of the increase shown in January. For the first two months of 2004, imports declined 2.1% compared to the same period in 2003. Total value of merchandise imports was recorded at EC\$15.4 million in comparison to EC\$ 17.1 million for 2003. The primary source of this decline were in imports of both Primary and Consumption Goods.

Consumption Goods imports decreased by 16.7% in February 2004 compared to February 2003. The main contributors of this decrease were Animal and Vegetable Oils, Fats and Waxes, which registered a 37.2% decline and Food and Live Animals which declined by 36.9% over 2003. Manufactured Goods increased by 11.4%, which contains items such as types, rods, tiles and sheets of plywood. All other categories showed an increased over their respective 2003 figures except Beverages and Tobacco which declined 11.5%.

Primary Goods Imports increased by 2.2% in February 2004 over its corresponding February 2003 figures. Chemicals and Related Product also registered a 23.1% increase while Crude Materials, decreased by 41.5%

Capital Goods imports increased by 0.5% in February 2004 over the same month in 2003, which comprises of a single category, Machinery & Transport Equipment.

Exports for the month of February 2004 were EC\$0.42 million a 58.4% decline from the 2003 figures. Domestic exports accounted 50.7% of the overall total exports and registered a 1.36% increase. It should be noted that overall exports include goods, which were previously imported into Anguilla.

February 2004 recorded a trade balance of EC\$15.0 million in deficit, a 6.7% decrease in the deficit compared to February 2003.
