Did you know? That section 3 (1) (d) of the Litter (Abatement) Ordinance 1987, states, "no person shall transport litter (garbage) in such a manner that it is scattered or is likely to be scattered in a public place while it is being transported."

Did you know? That household waste is made up of food scraps, paper wrappings, fruit and vegetative matter, tins and bottles.

Did you know? That Zone one (1) collection schedule is; Household Bins are collected on Mondays and Thursdays and Community Bins on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays.

Did you know? That Household and Community garbage is collected on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays and Saturdays in Zone Three (3).

Did you know? That Commercial waste includes unused blocks, bricks, concrete materials, tiles, old lumber, pallet boards, foam, sponges, wood drawers, chest of drawers, cupboards etc. This category contributed 22.45% in 2001 and dropped to 14.10% in 2004.

Did you know? That Zone Two (2) is the Central Zone, from Sandy Ground, North Hill, Upper South Hill (East of Methodist Church), Wallblake, Little Harbour, The Forest, The Quarter and Rey Hill.

Did you know? That in Zone Two (2), Household Bins are collected on Mondays and Fridays, and the Community Bins are collected Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

Did you know? Industrial waste includes galvanize sheets, bedsteads, iron, old stoves, refrigerators, washing machines, derelict vehicles, old metal drums, steel, bush leaves etc. These materials contributed to 9.93% of total waste collected in 2004.
